Find 8 glasses of the same size and set them out in line on a table and number them 1 – 8 using the pieces of paper.

Using the jug, fill the glasses with the amounts of water shown in the picture. Glass 1 will have the most and glass 8 the least.

Using the spoon to tap the glasses in the following order, try playing 'Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star'.
