Mud Painting

Find a muddy spot somewhere and use the stick to dig up some soil. Put the soil in your pot.

Add the water, a drop at a time. Stir with your stick until you get the right consistency. Too little water and it will be hard to paint with, too much water and it will be very faint.

Now you're ready to get painting! You could paint the path, a wall, a tree or some paper. You could draw some pretty patterns, make an animal out of a log or write your name. If you're leaving your painting outside, check back on it tomorrow and see if it's still there.
