Nature Alphabet

For children from Reception to KS3.

Step One

See what living thing you can spot and write down their name. Then add some describing words with the same starting letter, for example: **b**eautiful, **b**usy **b**umblebee.

Step Two

Try and spot more living things with names starting with different letters of the alphabet. Add your same starting letter describing words for them too.

Step Three

How many letters of the alphabet can you spot and what is the most describing words starting with the same letter you can use?

Step Four

When you have collected as many letters of the alphabet as you can, why not turn your list into a book? Draw pictures to illustrate your masterpiece!


