Parachute Jump!

Make your own parachute and see how small toys or different shapes can parachute jump!

This is an indoor or outdoor activity.



Step One

First cut a large square out of your bag or fabric.

Cut off the corners to the square to make an eight sided shape called an octagon.



Step Two

Make a small hole near each corner.

Cut your string (make it longer than your parachute is wide) into eight pieces the same length. Tie the string through the holes.




Step Three

Tie the other end of the eight strings around your object.



Step Four

Find a high place to slowly drop your parachute from. See how well it works. Try tying different objects onto your parachute to see how they float!
