## Pareidolia- Find Faces

Age: KS1- KS2

*Pareidolia is where you see a face in a object or in an unusual place. We all do it and good example is a house where the windows are the eyes and the door is its mouth.*

*You can make objects in your house or trees in your local greenspace look even more like faces by adding paper eyes*



### Kit List

- Paper
- Scissors
- Crayons
- Blotack
- Camera on phone (optional)

#### Step One

Cut out oval egg shapes from your paper to be the eyes. Colour a circle in the middle to be the eye iris and pupil

#### Step Two

Search your house or green space for a place where the eyes could help make a face, Tree trunks might be a good place to look. When you have something attach blotack to your paper eyes and place them on to make the face.
