Rain Painting

Create a beautiful image
on a rainy day – or by adding your
own ‘raindrops’.

Suitable for preschool to KS2.

Draw a colourful picture using your
felt tip pens – a rainbow works well.

When you’ve finished, put your
picture outside. You can either fix it to your
window with Blu-tack or Sellotape, hold it up
with a clothes peg or lay it flat on the ground.

If it’s a rainy day, leave the picture in
the rain to see how the raindrops transform the
picture. If it’s not rainy, splash or spray a little
water on to the paper.

Experiment by using paint or pencils instead of
pens. Or see the different way the rain affects a
picture laid flat and one hung up.


