

In January 2017, we asked for your views on proposals for changes to Sloane Street. We sent questionnaires to over 12,000 properties on Sloane Street and the surrounding area and held four public exhibitions.

We would like to thank all of you that gave us your views.



Highlights of the consultation results are:

- There is support for the proposals to change Sloane Street. Overall, three quarters of respondents (75 per cent) support (to some extent) the proposals for Sloane Street; this included 51 per cent who 'strongly support' the proposals
- The preferred option for the central section of the road was the option with maximum pavement widening. Over half (53 per cent) of all respondents preferred this option
- The majority of respondents (58 per cent) favoured the traditional style for improvements
- The most common concern about the proposals was the effect of narrowing the road will have on traffic in the area

Next steps

We will take in to account all the responses and comments from the public consultation and prepare a detailed design for the whole road based on maximum widening of the pavements and using traditional style materials and street furniture. We will incorporate within the final design as many of the suggestions that are feasible and practical from those that responded to the consultation and will pay particular attention to ensuring that the narrowing of the road will not adversely affect the traffic flow.
