Spider Webs

A spider builds a spiral shaped web out of sticky silk and uses it to capture insects. You can make your own web to hang in your house or garden.

Step One

Collect three equal sized sticks and form a star shape. Cut a piece of string and tie together all three sticks to create the frame.

Step Two



Cut a long piece of string, and tie one end on top of the centre knot. To start to wrap, begin close to the middle and wrap the string once around the stick, gently pull and do the same with the next stick. Keep the string tight and carefully work your way outwards.

Step Three

Once you have reached the end; create a loop in the leftover string and hang it.
