About us

This year the Ecology Service is promoting a great range of walks, talks and workshops giving people a chance to explore some of our Sites of Nature Conservation Importance.

We also have the exciting prospect of moving into our new, purpose-built Ecology Centre in Holland Park. We will be moving into the new building in September and you can keep updated on the progress via our website and Facebook page.

The Ecology Service work includes:

- promoting awareness and understanding of biodiversity and the local environment through formal and informal education
- · protecting sites which are important for nature conservation
- · developing local policies for nature conservation
- advising on the management of open spaces to enhance biodiversity within the borough

Environmental Visits for Schools

The Centre provides a key facility for local schools to study and enjoy the natural environment, and can be booked for field trips and environmental education workshops throughout the year. Outdoor investigations take place in the Holland Park Wildlife Area, which features a wildlife pond with a dipping platform, woodland and grassland habitats. Visiting groups can work independently or with a member of staff.

Forest School

The Ecology Service offers Forest School in Holland Park: a programme of regular nature sessions for school groups in our woodland environment run by qualified staff. Children participate in activities and games designed to build self esteem, communication skills, independence and self confidence through an appreciation of the natural environment.

Children's Holiday Activities

The Ecology Centre runs a scheme of outdoor and creative activities for five to 12 year olds in the spring, summer, and half-term holidays.

How to get there

The Ecology Centre is situated in the middle of Holland Park. Entrance to the park is via Ilchester Place Gate, Abbotsbury Road Car Park, Duchess of Bedford Gate or from Holland Walk and Holland Park Avenue.

Please note: the Ecology Centre will be moving to a new building in September. This will be located near the Abbotsbury Road entrance, next to the Adventure Playground. There will be signs to the new location once we have moved.

We strongly advise using public transport if possible.
