
Education of Residents

Notes

The figures above are **estimates**. They have been calculated using imported and exported pupils data, along with Office of National Statistics (ONS) population data (2008 mid-year estimates). **The data should be treated with caution due to the unstable nature of population estimates.**

Comments

- Of an estimated 12,268 children of primary school age living in Kensington and Chelsea 39% attend a RBKC primary school (4,733).
- Of an estimated 7,094 children of secondary school age living in Kensington and Chelsea 21% attend a RBKC secondary school (1,490).
- A higher proportion of primary school aged residents attend local schools than secondary school aged children (39% compared to 21%).
- 3% of primary aged residents attended maintained schools out of the Borough, compared to 21% at secondary.
- The proportion of primary and secondary aged residents attending private/other education was similar (58% and 56%, respectively).
- The proportion of local children attending private/other education is considerably higher than the average England and London rate of 7%.
