Sticky Colours

A Forest School classic!

*How many colours do you think there are?
Make yourself a portable sticky card to
take on an adventure and see how many
you can find!*

Step
One

Cut yourself a piece of card roughly the size of a bank card. If you have double sided tape, place 2 rows onto the card and peel off the protective layer. If you are using normal tape, fold in half and press tightly onto the card (see photo →)

Step
Two

Now you're ready to get collecting!
Take your card on a walk in the park, or even just in your garden. Look on the ground for different colours – Leaves? Fallen flowers? Stones? Make sure you only use a piece smaller than a fingernail so you can fit lots of colours. REMEMBER not to pick anything living or growing.

Step
Three

You can make your sticky colours into a pattern, into a collage, into a badge or perhaps use it as a secret pass to get into your room!

Kit List

- A piece of card (or paper)
- Tape (preferably double sided, but normal is fine)
- Scissors
