### CONDITION(S) AND REASON(S) FOR THEIR IMPOSITION

- 1. The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this permission. (C001)

  Reason As required by Section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, to avoid the accumulation of unexercised Planning Permissions. (R001)
- 2. The development hereby permitted shall be carried out exactly and only in accordance with the drawings and other particulars forming part of the permission and there shall be no variation therefrom without the prior written approval of the Local Planning Authority. (C068)

  Reason The details are considered to be material to the acceptability of the proposals, and for safeguarding the amenity of the area. (R068)
- 3. Full particulars of the following shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Executive Director, Planning and Conservation before the development hereby permitted commences and the development shall not be carried out otherwise than in accordance with the details so approved:
  - (a) the removable railings at a scale of 1:20. (C011)

<u>Reason</u> - The particulars hereby reserved are considered to be material to the acceptability of the development, and the Local Planning Authority wishes to ensure that the details of the development are satisfactory. (R011)

- 4. The tables and chairs shall be removed from the pavement between 22.00 hours and 09.00 hours the following day.

  Reason To safeguard the amenities of the area.
- 5. On each day the tables and chairs are placed outside the premises, the occupier shall ensure the immediate area is kept litter free.

  Reason To safeguard the amenities of the area.
- 6. This permission shall be personal to Caffe Nero and shall not enure for the benefit of the land. (C006)

<u>Reason</u> - In granting this permission the Local Planning Authority has had regard to the special circumstances of the case/applicant, and considers that use otherwise than by Caffe Nero would have had different implications, and would be likely to have resulted in planning permission being refused. (R006)
