REASON(S) FOR REFUSAL:

1. The proposed telecommunications antennae, by reason of their size, fixing, position, visual prominance, and cumulative impact, would result in unacceptable high level clutter on the building, to the detriment of its character and appearance, and the character and appearance of this part of the Chelsea Park/Stanley Conservation Area. As such, the proposal is contrary to Policies CD44a, CD44b, CD45, CD52 and CD53 of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea Unitary Development Plan and alterations thereto.

INFORMATIVE(S)

- 1. You are advised that a number of relevant policies of the Unitary Development Plan and proposed alterations thereto were used in the determination of this case, in particular, Policies CD44a, CD44b, CD45, CD52 and CD53. (I51)
- You are advised that the permission granted in respect of the existing antennae on the building (granted 2.7.99, Ref. PP/99/623) showed the antenna to be located on the north eastern elevation of the lift housing in a different position to its current location on the building. You are advised that the antenna should be moved to its approved position to avoid the Royal Borough taking enforcement action in respect of this breach of planning control. Furthermore, Condition 3 of the planning permission requires the antennae to be painted to match the brickwork. It is noted that the antenna on the south west corner has not been painted to match the brickwork of the chimney to which it is affixed. You are advised to paint the antenna as required by the condition to avoid enforcement proceedings being instigated for a Breach of Condition.
