I refer to your town planning application for the erection of an additional storey at the above address.

Further to your telephone conversation today with my assistant, Mrs. Wilden, I confirm that planning permission reference TP/91/1209 dated 25th October 1991 for the erection of a mansard roof extension, two storey rear extension, conversion to a single family dwelling and elevational alterations has been implemented by the undertaking of the conversion, rear extension and elevational alterations. Accordingly, the permission remains valid and the mansard roof addition shown on the drawings approved under that application can be implemented without a need for further town planning permission.

It is my opinion that the installation of a glazed rooflight on the top of the mansard roof, as shown on your drawing 20 L Sq./00/03P, may be treated as a non-material alteration to the approved scheme provided that the rooflight is fitted flush with the approved roof section, with no projection above the surrounding roof top as discussed.

Therefore, I have treated your application as withdrawn. The Town Planning fee will be refunded under separate cover.
