

CONDITIONS AND REASONS FOR THEIR IMPOSITION



- 1. A maximum of three tables and seven chairs shall be placed upon the pavement at any one time and these shall be placed only in the positions indicated on Drawing No: A3/3408/SK 101/Rev 1.
 - Reason: To safeguard the amenities of neighbouring properties.
- 2. The tables and chairs hereby approved shall be removed from the pavement by 23.00 hours on any day and no part of the public highway shall be used for restaurant purposes after that time or before 08.00 hours the following day.

 Reason: To safeguard the amenities of neighbouring properties.
- 3. This permission shall be personal to Zagros Corporation Ltd and shall not enure for the benefit of the land. (C006)

<u>Reason</u> - In granting this permission the local planning authority has had regard to the special circumstances of the case, and considers that use otherwise than by Zagros Corporation Ltd. would have had different implications, and would be likely to have resulted in planning permission being refused. (R006)

4. The tables and chairs hereby permitted shall be retained for a limited period only until 31 January 2001 on or before which date the use shall be discontinued. (C004)

<u>Reason</u> - There is insufficient evidence available at this stage to assess the impact of the development, and permission for a limited period will allow the authority to reassess the development in the light of experience of the use. (R004)

- 1. Your attention is drawn to the Conditions of this Permission and to the Council's powers of enforcement, including the power to serve a Breach of Condition Notice under the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, as amended. (I10)
- 2. Before placing any structures, including tables, chairs, or advertisements, on the public highway, you are advised to consult the Directorate of Transportation and Highways, Room 317, Town Hall, Hornton Street W8 7NX (0171-361-2103) regarding consent under the Highways Act which may be required. Separate approval for the works hereby granted planning permission may be required by the Building Act 1984 and the Building Regulations 1991, and the grant of planning permission does not imply that such approval will be given. The Director of Building Control, Town Hall, Hornton Street, W8 7NX should be consulted before works commence. (I21)
