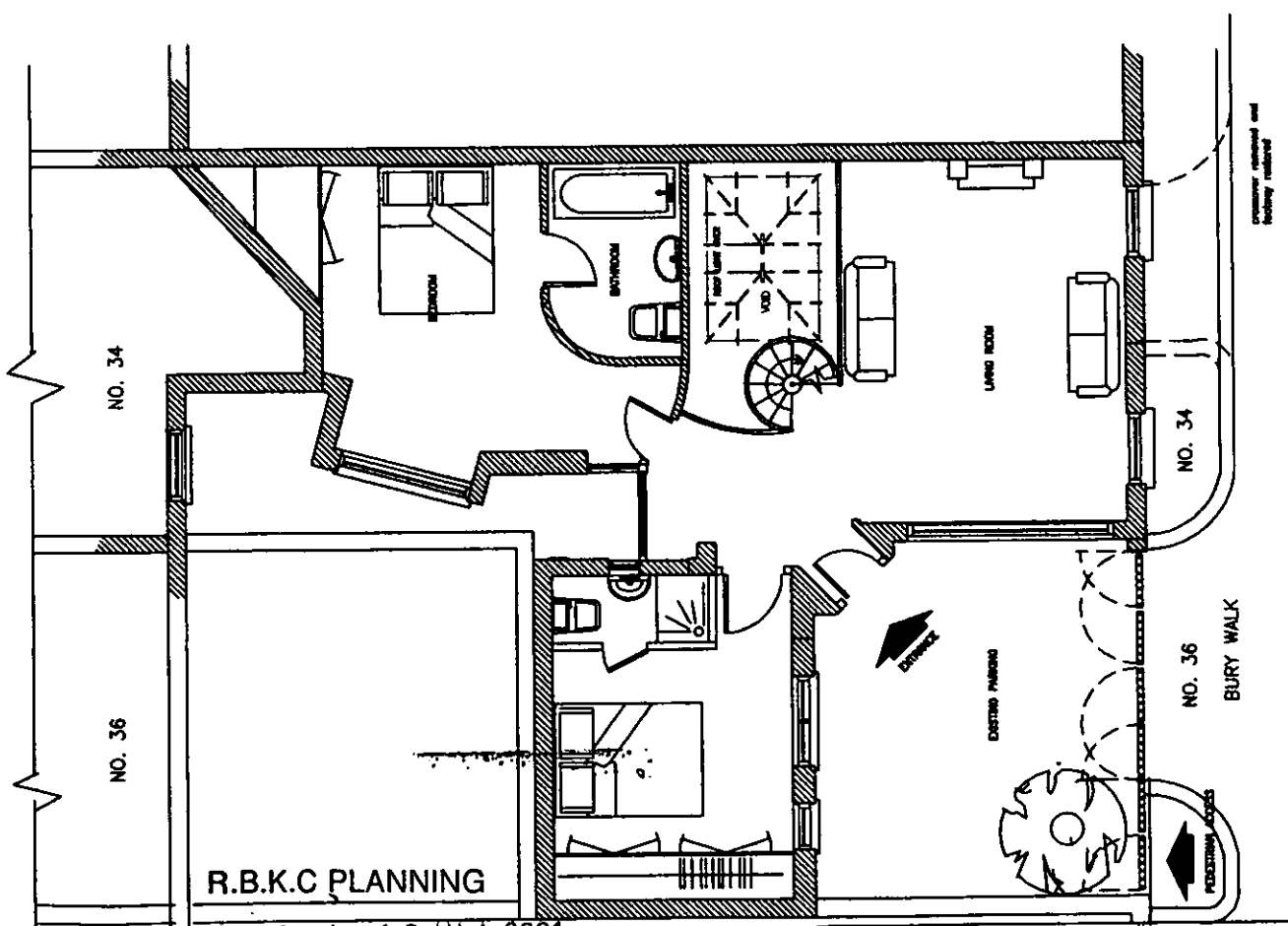
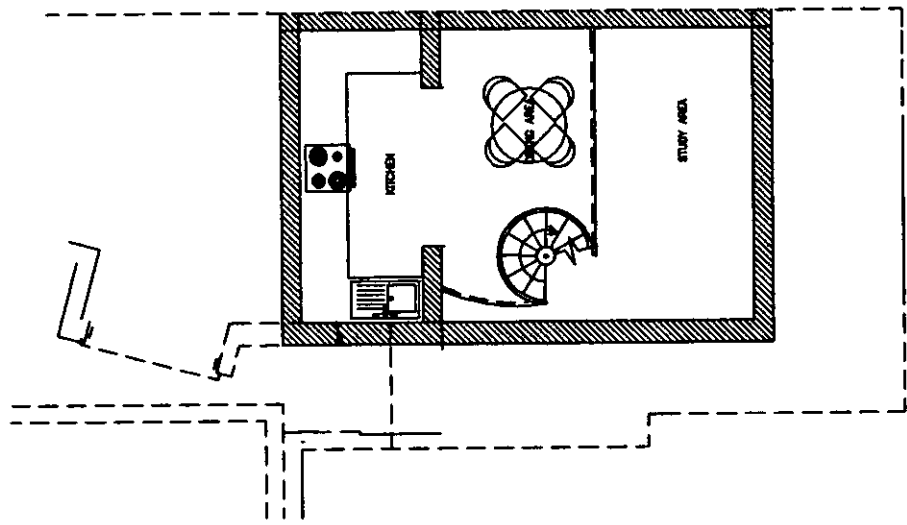
... Perhaps you can give this some consideration. I am away from London until 25<sup>th</sup> October and I will telephone you on my return.
