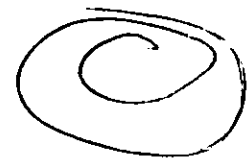

The Council is required by the Secretary of State for the Environment to consider all planning applications expeditiously. Any letter of support or objection should be received as soon as possible within 14 days of the date of this letter, although later objections, if received in time, will be reported to the Council Committee meeting which decides the application. An early response gives the Council's Officers the opportunity to encourage applicants to amend their plans in the light of objections received, and the application may therefore be amended before it is decided. 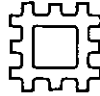
