Dear Sarah,

I have enclosed a drawing that provides a representation of the main façade and the proposal to return a newly installed window back to a doorway below our Apartments entry stair.

I believe the windows installation was part of a non material change that had been undertaken just before our client finalised the purchase of the property and we had been unable to stop the alteration. The proposed scheme means that the arrangement had been developed with the doorway as a necessity and its loss has implications on our layout. We simply require your response on removing the window and reinstating the old door back into the previous opening. This would return the façade to a condition upon which the previous approval had been granted and we feel that such a reversion should again reflect a non material change.
