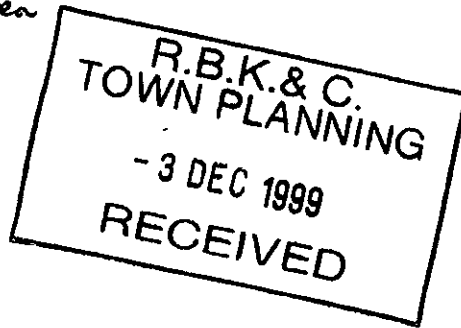

Re: Satellite Dish Installation on a listed Building

Thanks for the telephone conversation today which I found very fruitful. I would be very grateful if you would consider this letter as a formal application for the installation of a Satellite Dish at the above mentioned property.

In accordance with the Town Planning Regulations, the dish would be an 80 cm mesh dish unobtrusively located on one of the vertical surfaces of the chimney (of dark brown brick) in the out of view roof area. It would be installed professionally by a registered co. for satellite installation purposes. Moreover, it would be installed in a similar fashion to other similar satellite dishes in the neighbourhood. I also need to point out that this would be the second dish at the same address which I believe falls within the limits of having 2 or 3 dishes per household.

My reason for installing a dish and not using other similar facilities like Cable TV or On-Digital is pretty straightforward. My career is based on international business, London being the perfect scenario for such career development. This relies on keeping up with my extra and fundamental skills in modern languages.
