

I am writing today with regards to the planning application made by Mr C. Celecia for the installation of a 80cm diameter satellite dish at roof level of the building at 81 Queen's Gate, London SW7 5JU. It is my understanding that the planning application is dated 17/12/1999 and that Mr C. Celecia is subletting one of the rooms of Flat 4 at the same address.

I am the leasehold owner of the roof terrace at the above address as shown in the excerpt of the Leaseholder Agreement attached. I understand from the planning application sign outside the building that Mr Celecia plans to install a satellite dish that would overhang my roof terrace and my airspace.

I would like to bring to your attention that I object to the granting of such planning permission on the basis that Mr Celecia does not have any Deed of Easement and therefore does not have any right to install a satellite dish over my roof terrace.

I have enclosed copies of the letters sent to Mr Celecia and to the Landlord of the building earlier today.
