CONDITIONS AND REASONS FOR THEIR IMPOSITION

23

1. **The works hereby permitted shall be carried out exactly and only in accordance with the drawings, and other particulars, forming part of the Consent, and there shall be no variation therefrom without the prior written approval of the local planning authority (C205)**
Reason - In order to safeguard the special architectural or historic interest of the building (R205)

2. **All new works and works of making good to the retained fabric, whether internal or external, shall be finished to match the adjacent work with regard to the methods used and to colour, material, texture, and profile (C206)**
Reason - In order to safeguard the special architectural or historic interest of the building (R206)

3. **Suitable precautions must be taken to secure and protect the interior elements against accidental loss or damage during building work, and no such elements may be disturbed or removed temporarily or permanently except as indicated on the approved drawings or with the prior written approval of the local planning authority (C214)**
Reason - In order to safeguard the special architectural or historic interest of the building (R211)

4. **The works hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this consent (C201)**
Reason - As required by Section 18 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas Act) 1990, to avoid the accumulation of consents (R201)


