new build property adjacent to 12 Codrington Mews


in the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea shall be known and described as:

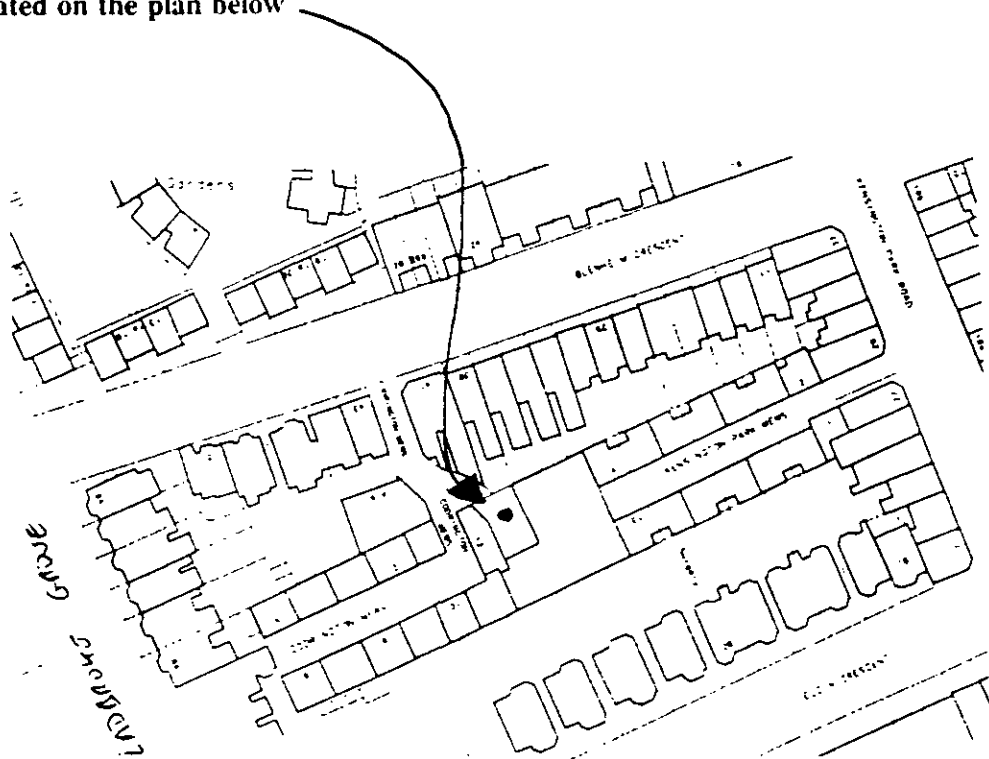
