NAMING/NUMBERING OF BUILDINGS

The Council in pursuance of the provisions of section ii of the London Building Acts (Amendment) Act 1939 HEREBY ORDERS THAT, for the purpose of distinguishing it, the new retail/residential development on a site in Gloucester Road between Queens Gate Terrace and Elvaston Place in the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea shall be known and described as:

retail units, public house and off license: 17, 19, 21, 23, 25, 27, 29, 31, 33 and 35 Gloucester Road

block of 92 flats: Citadines Aparthotel, 35A Gloucester Road

and that any existing names/numbers which differ therefrom shall be abolished.

This Order shall take effect from and including the FIRST DAY of AUGUST 1996.

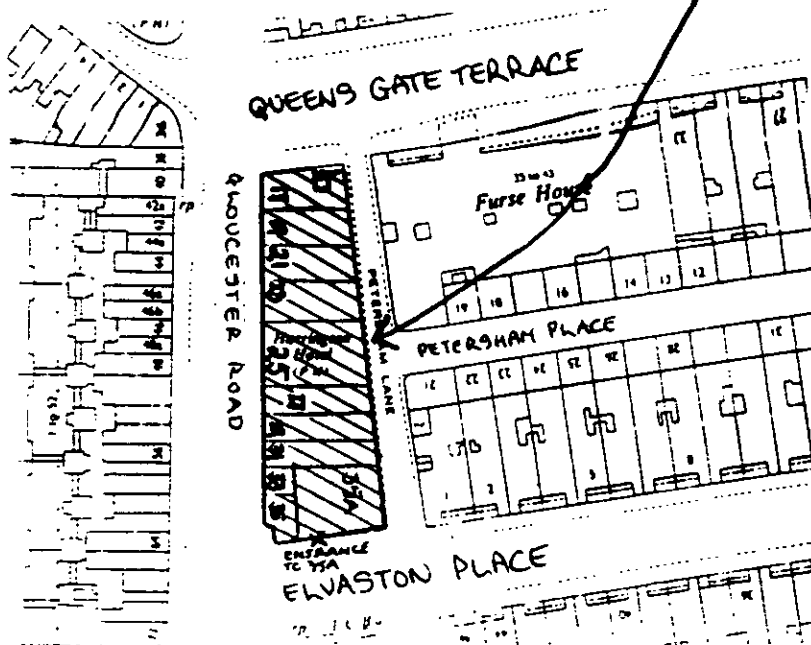
