Residential moorings, Grand Union Canal, Paddington Arm


in the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea shall be known and described as:

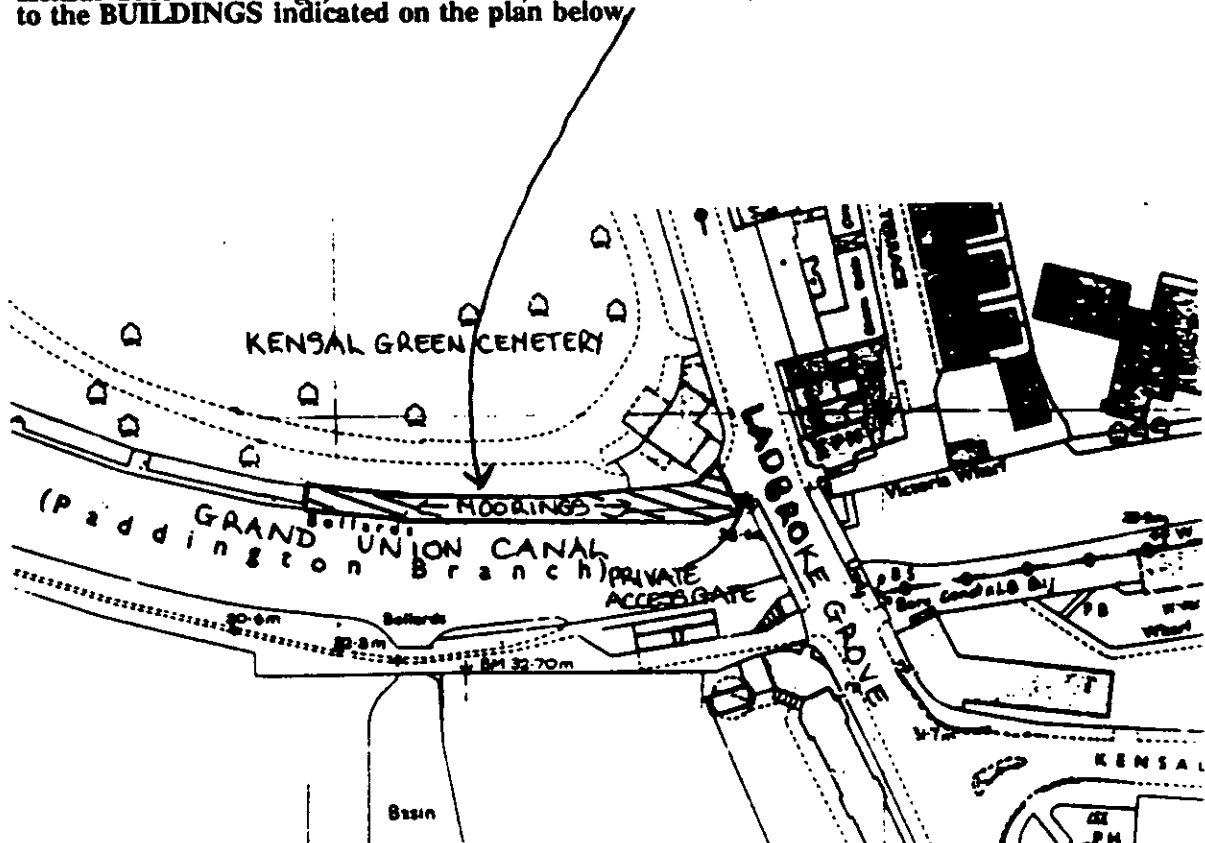
