The drawings show concrete paving to adoptable standards. At the meeting, we suggested a Charcon product which comes in various sizes (400x400mm would probably be best) but also showed a granite sample and some standard PC paving. At the meeting, we agreed that granite was not used anywhere nearby and the concrete might be more suitable for the Riverside Walk as this would tie in better with the riverside walk in front of Chelsea harbour.

I understand that you have taken over the Lots Road Power Station case, following the departure of Georgina Slader and more recently Debrah Silver.

I thought that I would drop you a quick note to bring you up to speed on this, in case Debrah did not have time before she left. A meeting took place on 16<sup>th</sup> December between ourselves, HWP and Townshends with Debrah Silver, Geoff Burrage, Richard Craig and Saskie Lovell to discuss the remaining conditions to be discharged, namely the following:

- Condition 7 (Hard and soft landscaping);
- Condition 9 (Riverside Walk);
- · Condition 12 (Treatment of Creek);
- Condition 25 (Archaeology) partial discharge.

In respect of the above conditions, the following actions were agreed:

Condition 7: A further set of plans were sent through by ourselves for the attention of Debrah Silver on 17<sup>th</sup> December, as Richard Craig had not seen the latest drawings. From the comments raised at the meeting, it did not seem as though Richard had any significant concerns, but he is due to review the plans in more detail and come back with any comments.

Condition 9: At the meeting, Geoff recognised that the use of Yorkstone may not be appropriate for the riverside walk, but would speak to his Director and the officer at LBHF with regard to the choice of material. GB to confirm the type of material.

Condition 12: Saskie Lovell has contacted the GLA who have confirmed that they do not wish to comment on the submitted Management Plan, given that we have already consulted with the relevant bodies. (The EA have already given their approval to these details and LBHF have discharged the condition for their Borough). Saskie is due to provide information to us on suggested options for capital works to Chelsea Basin. All other queries / comments previously raised by Saskie were discussed and resolved at the meeting.

Condition 25 – Debrah was going to grant a further partial discharge of this condition as the only remaining item to be submitted is the 'Historic Building Report' which should be available towards the end of January 2009. She was going to send the letter out on 19<sup>th</sup> December confirming that the 'Historic Building Report' is the only item required to be submitted to fully discharge this condition, but we are yet to receive this. Is it possible this letter could be emailed through?

I would be very grateful to receive any update on the above as we are extremely keen to maintain the momentum following our productive meeting held before Christmas, as we feel we are at a stage now where the conditions, which were submitted for approval a considerable time ago, could be

signed off fairly soon. Alternatively, maybe Geoff / Saskie / Richard could let me know where they are with their actions. If necessary, we would be happy to meet with you to provide a briefing as to the project as a whole.

I hope this is helpful, but if you have any queries, please let me know. I look forward to hearing from you.

Further to our recent telephone conversation, please see attached a further copy of the document previously submitted pursuant to approval of details for condition 9 (Riverside Walk) of planning permission ref. PP/02/01324.

As discussed at our meeting held on 16<sup>th</sup> December 2008, we have now received confirmation from Geoff Burrage of your Council's Transport and Highways Department that the use of precast concrete would be acceptable (email dated 24<sup>th</sup> February 2009). Many thanks for your email.

We have discussed this issue with Paul Goodacre at LBHF at regular meetings over the last few weeks. It is our understanding that LBHF are not seeking York Stone, but the main objective is for the paving material for the riverside walk for both Boroughs to be consistent to achieve a comprehensive design approach.

When we met in December, it was recognised that your Council's preference is for York Stone, but that artificial stone paving is also considered acceptable, as stated in the Streetscape Guide. It was agreed that, although a preference, Yorkstone would not be an appropriate material for the Riverside Walk. It was agreed that the use of concrete paving would be more suitable as this would tie in better with the riverside walk in front of Chelsea Harbour and the surrounding area as there is little use of Yorkstone in the vicinity of the site, as shown on the attached drawing. This was subsequently confirmed by Geoff Burrage.

The LBHF Streetsmart Guide also allows for the use of ASP. As such, from our discussions with LBHF, given that your Council had agreed ASP in this location, LBHF would have no issue with this and would also consider ASP to be acceptable and would therefore not seek Yorkstone.

It was therefore our understanding that although there is a preference for Yorkstone, having demonstrated that this would not be a suitable material for the riverside walk and agreed with your officers that ASP would be more appropriate, LBHF would also agree to the use of ASP to ensure a consistent use of material across both Boroughs.

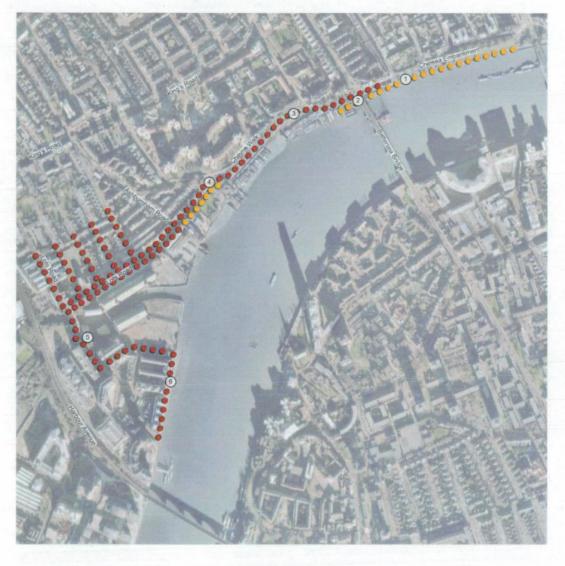

**Comments:** The application seeks to discharge condition nine of PP/02/1324. The condition relates to the details of the riverside walk, which is to be adopted by the Council.

The applicant is seeking approval to use grey natural stone paving. Previous discussions have made clear that the Council requires York Stone paving at this location. This is to ensure consistency with the design of the walk on the Hammersmith and Fulham side of the scheme and more generally with future sections of the riverside walk.

I maintain that position and therefore object to condition nine being discharged. The applicant should consider a design solution that incorporates York Stone paving with their broader scheme. This will ensure consistency with UDP policy TR3 and proposed submission Core Strategy polices CT1 (f), (m) and CR4 (a).

Thank you for your time at the meeting today. Please find attached drawings from the original Planning Consent files. Apologies for the quality, but I trust that it highlights the principles of planting to vertical walls and the ramp around the base of KC-1.

With regard to any requirement for designated outdoor Nursery Play space. We have reviewed the original Planning Consented landscape drawings (attached plan), the EIA and the S106 which makes no reference to any such provision being made. The only reference we can locate with the Consent is within the Planning Conditions where we advise:

Condition 16: Not withstanding the provisions of the Town & Country Planning (Use Clauses) Order 1987 (or any order revoking and re-enacting that Order with or without modification) the ground floor unit in Building KC2A shown as a nursery shall be used solely as a Use Class D1(b) creche or day nursery unless otherwise agreed in writing by the local planning authority..

We will update the drawings for the Riverside Walk as discussed today and issue in due course.

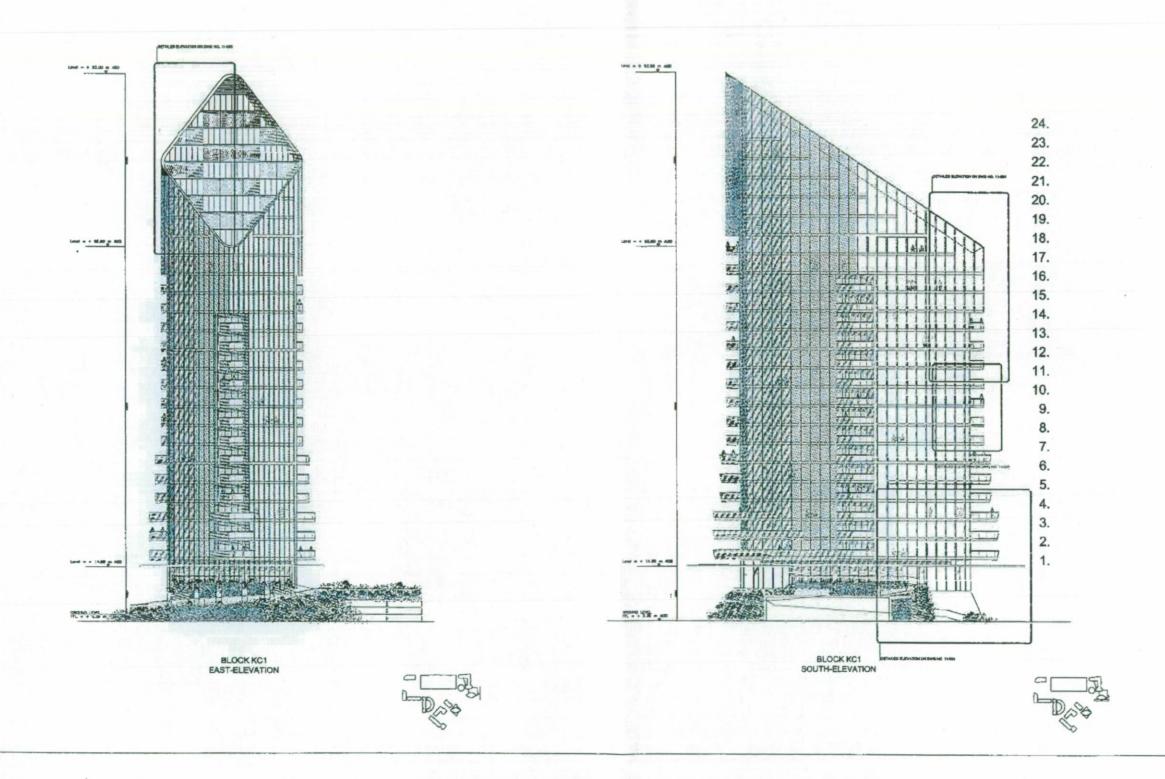

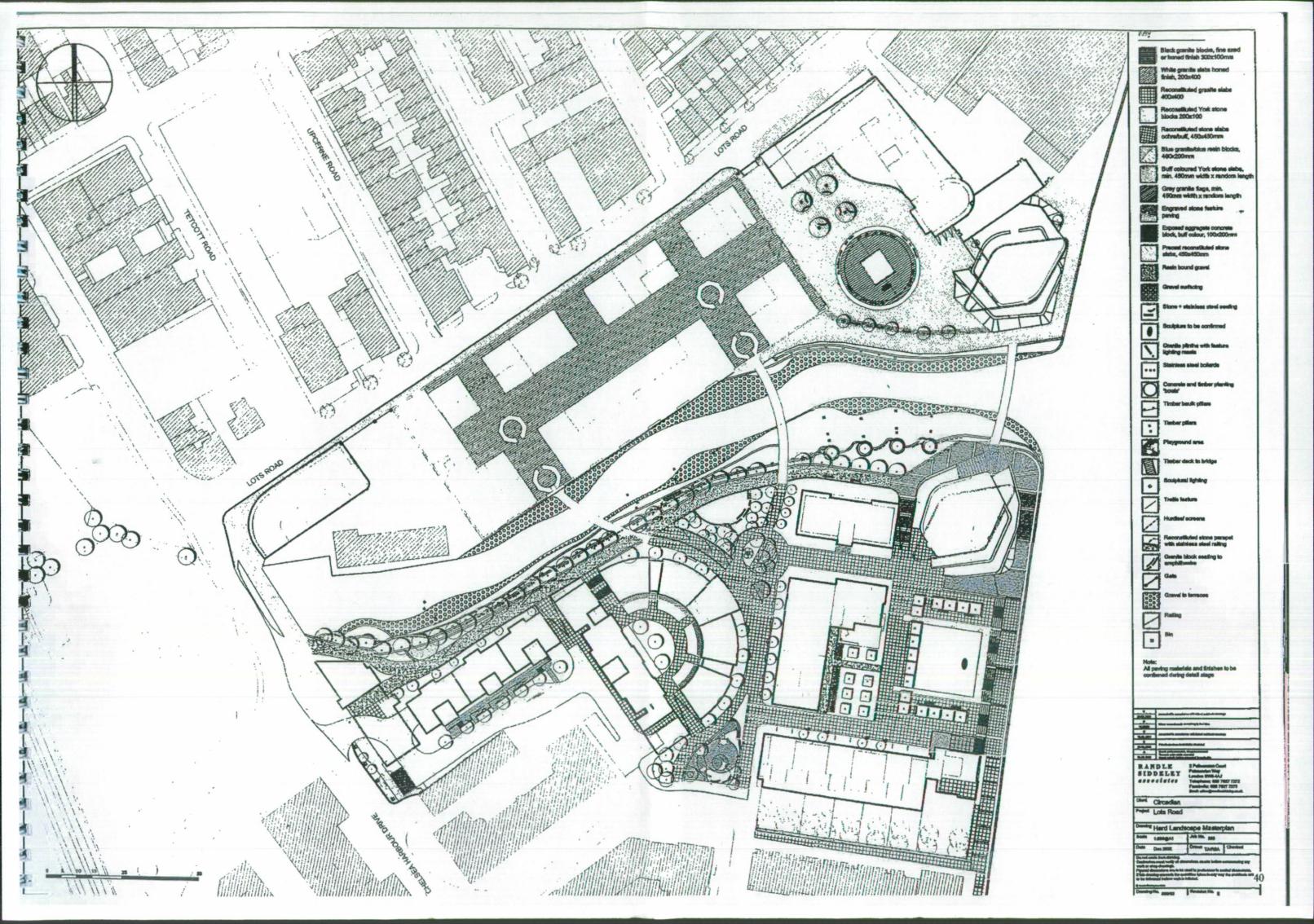

The proposal involves using grey natural stone paving along the Riverside Walk. Previous discussions have made clear that the Council requires York Stone paving at this location this is to ensure consistency with the design of the walk on the Hammersmith and Fulham Council side of the scheme and more generally with future sections of the riverside walk. As such, it is considered that the proposal is contrary to UDP Policy TR3 and Submission Core Strategy Policies CT1 (f) and (m) and CR4 (a).

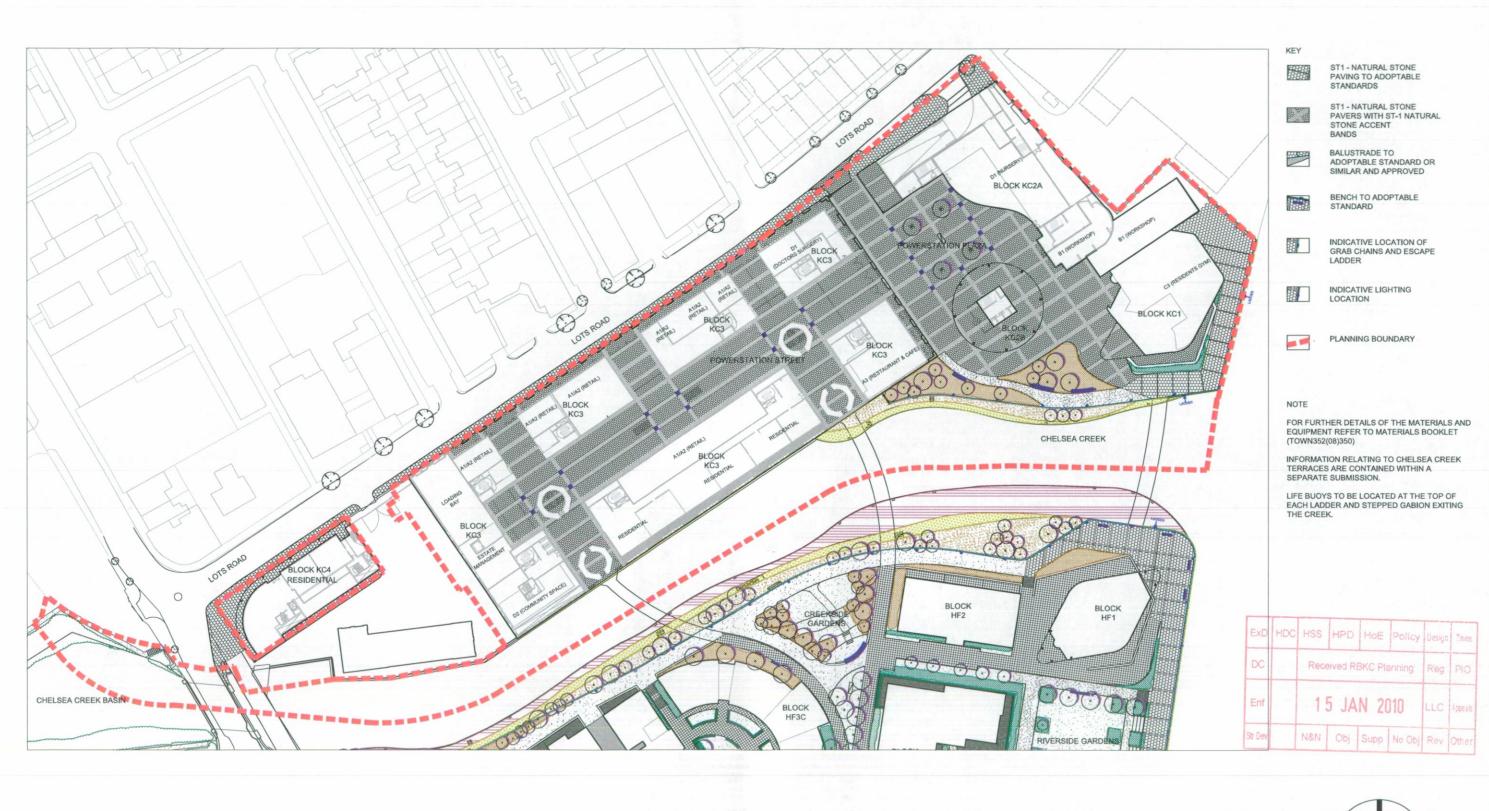
