If it has not been possible to offer your child a place at your preferred school, you have the right to appeal to an independent appeal panel. A step-by-step guide is provided to assist you in the appeals process.

Appeals timetable for 2019 entry

Primary Reception Class appeals 2019

National Offer Day - 16 April 2018

Appeal forms for community primary schools dispatched from 6 May 2019

Appeals to be lodged for community schools by 24 May 2019

Appeal hearings scheduled throughout June/July 2019.

Secondary Transfer appeals 2019

National Offer Day - 1 March 2018

Appeals for schools administered by the Council dispatched from 1 April 2019

Completed appeals to be lodged by 10 May 2019

Appeal hearings scheduled throughout June and July 2019

The above timetable may not apply to all schools in Kensington and Chelsea or other council areas. It is important that you check with the individual school you want to appeal for to check their timetable.
