

## Planning enforcement pilots

### Monitoring development sites

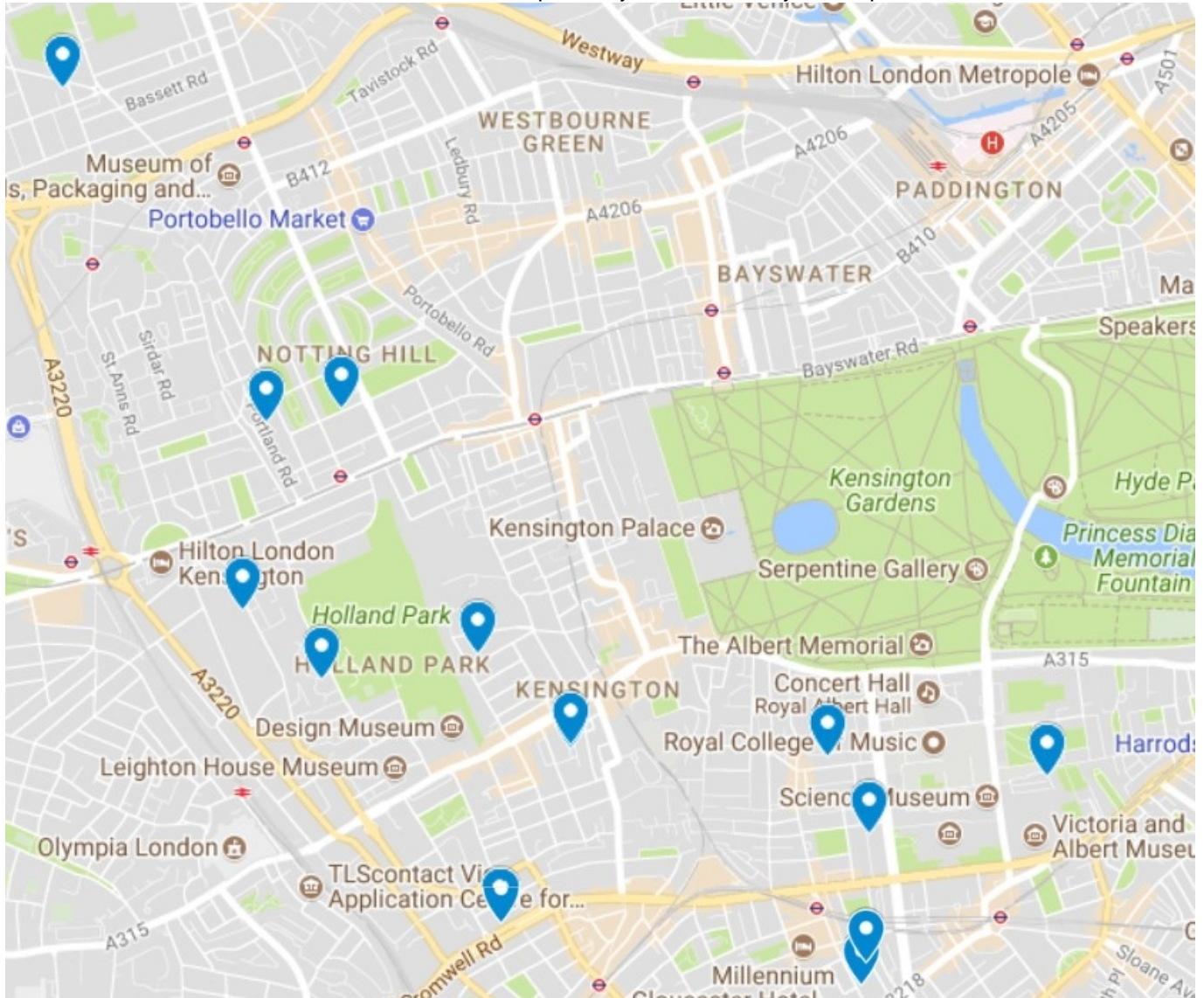
Development sites need to be well run and comply with regulations. It's our responsibility to investigate any alleged cases of unauthorised development and pro-actively monitor development sites.

Our pilot team are responsible for a number of important development sites in the borough and they work to uphold the Council's enforcement policies.

They regularly monitor sites and take a zero tolerance approach to enforcement breaches.

### Kensington enforcement pilot

There are over 20 construction sites in Kensington that have a construction traffic management plan. These sites have been selected either due to their size or close proximity to other nearby development sites.

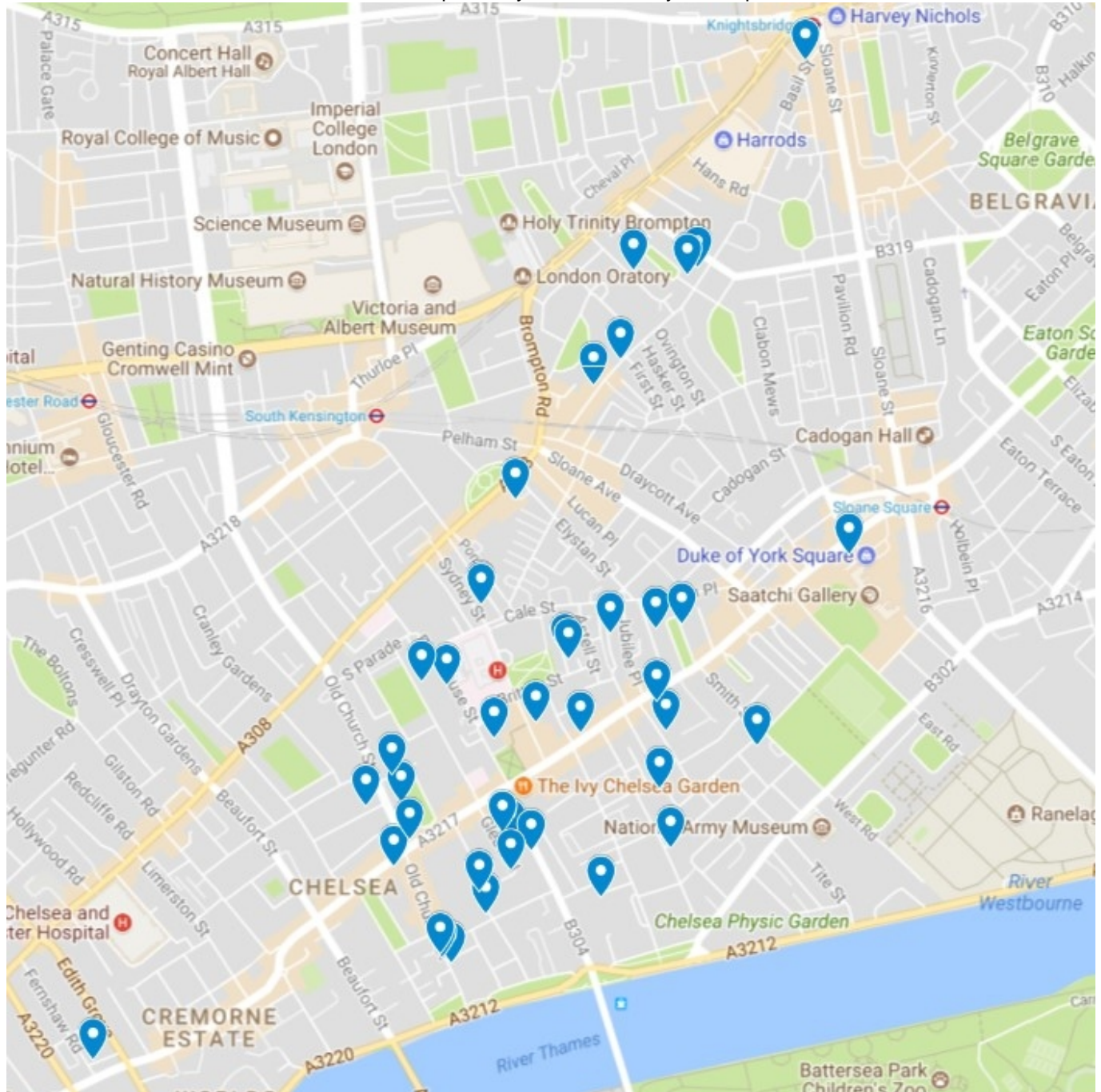

## Supporting evidence

You need to supply supporting evidence with your complaint such as photographs or videos that are time and date stamped. This will enable us to serve a notice or prosecute an enforcement breach.

Evidence must demonstrate beyond doubt that there's been an enforcement breach. For example if a construction vehicle is entering a site out of agreed hours you would need to document:

- the vehicle entering the site
- its registration plate
- or speak to the driver for verbal confirmation if you can't take a photo or video

If you submit evidence you may need to provide a witness statement and/or act as a witness for the prosecution in court.
