The Grenfell Community Assembly is a new forum that gives the Grenfell community the opportunity to come together and discuss the issues that matter to them.

It offers a chance for residents to take part in real conversations and honest exchanges of views for everyone involved in the process.

Meetings will be held approximately eight weeks in North Kensington and will focus on different themes each time, depending on what residents want to discuss.

The new Grenfell Community Assembly met for the first time in September. Over 40 residents were joined by councillors, local community groups and service providers to discuss health and wellbeing.
