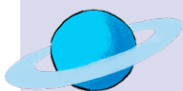


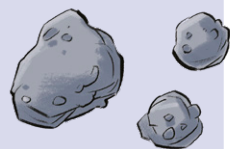

Zoom Zoom Rockets!

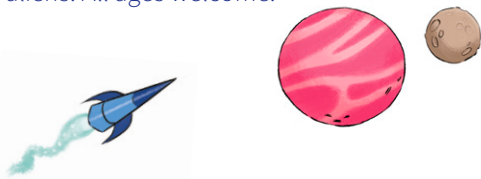
Saturday 6 August, 12 noon to 1pm
