Earl's Court Shopfront Design Guide Supplementary Planning Document (SPD)

In accordance with Regulation 14(a)(ii) of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended), an Adoption Statement is hereby made available.

The Council adopted the Earl's Court Shopfront Design Guide Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 20 March 2026.

The Council has undertaken a six-week consultation on a Draft version of the Earl's Court Shopfront Design Guide. The consultation was undertaken in accordance with Regulation 12 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended). The Council made modifications to the SPD following the consultation to take account of representations. Detailed comments and how the Council considered them are presented in separate consultation schedules available on the Council's website.

Requirement to make the documents available

Under Regulation 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended) the Local Planning Authority must make both this Adoption Statement and the final SPD "available" within our principal office, the website and in other such locations as specified in our Statement of Community Involvement. The documents are available on the Council's Planning Policy webpage and will be available in both the Town Hall, Hornton Street, and in all the Council's libraries as soon as possible.

Period of Challenge

In accordance with Regulations 11 (2)(c) and (d) of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended), any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the supplementary planning document may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review. Any such application must be made promptly and, in any event, not later than 3 months after the date on which the supplementary planning document was adopted i.e. starting from 20 March 2026.
