## ADVANCE NOTICE of Proposed Construction - Golborne Road, W10

I write to confirm details of the construction programme starting on 12 September 2016 in Golborne Road. A copy of the improvement plans can be found on the Council website. I have attached a plan showing the proposed sequence in which we propose the scheme will be implemented. The first phase A1 will start at the South East corner of Golborne Road j/w St Ervans Road. A second team will also start in Swinbrook Road on 12 September. Parking for the traders and retailers that use Swinbrook Road will be made available elsewhere until this area is complete.

The construction works will be undertaken between 0800 and 1800 hrs Monday to Saturday but this may vary dependent on work activities.
