KENSINGTON AND CHELSEA For the first time in its 54-year history, Notting Hill Carnival is moving entirely online over the August bank holiday weekend, 29-31 August 2020. Due to the Coronavirus pandemic, Carnival will not take its usual form this year, on the streets of Notting Hill, but there is an alternative:

Notting Hill Carnival 2020: Access All Areas

The Carnival community has come together to create a three-day digital programme streaming for free over four channels, so that everyone can enjoy the true spirit of Carnival from home while helping to protect lives and limit the spread of Coronavirus. It keeps Notting Hill Carnival alive at this challenging time, giving an outlet to the thousands of people that spend all year creating incredible costumes and amazing music for Europe's largest event.

Street Cleaning and Waste Collection

In Kensington and Chelsea, on Bank Holiday Monday there will be normal rubbish and recycling collections but no Too Big for the Bin bulky waste collections. Please ensure you put your rubbish and recycling out before 7am on your day of collection (not the night before). Local garden waste collections will operate as normal on Wednesday 2 September. If your waste is not collected by the City Council, please check with your private commercial waste collector for their service provision during the bank holiday weekend. If they cannot collect, then please do not place waste on Westminster's streets.
