Section 50 Licence

New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 Works Promoter Application Form

Applicants not familiar with the requirements of the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 (NRSWA) legislation are strongly advised to seek professional advice and to appoint an organisation with the appropriate knowledge to complete a Section 50 licence application and undertake the works on their behalf. Noncompliance with any requirements of the legislation may result in legal enforcement action being taken.

1. Requirement for a Licence

- 1.1. Section 50 of the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 ("the Act") requires that any person, body or organisation (other than those bodies or organisations who have the benefit of specific statutory rights) must apply for a licence in order to place or retain apparatus in the street and thereafter inspect, maintain, adjust, repair, alter, renew, reconfigure/relocate or remove such apparatus from the street.
- 1.2. The term apparatus includes a sewer, drain or tunnel and any structure for the lodging or access to them. It also includes cables, ducts and water and gas pipes.
- 1.3. The licence may authorise the placing of the apparatus and the carrying out of any works incidental to it (for instance, the breaking up or opening of the street or any sewer, drain, tunnel under it, or tunnelling or boring in the street). Applicants should note that the grant of a licence does not dispense with the need for the applicant to obtain any other consents, licences or permission that may be required. If in doubt about what consents may be required, applicants are strongly advised to seek professional advice.
- 1.4. Any work undertaken in the street in breach of this requirement constitutes a criminal offence under section 51 of the Act and the offending person, body or organisation may be liable on summary conviction to an unlimited fine.

2. Terms of the Licence

- 2.1. A licence may be granted to the applicant on terms permitting or prohibiting its assignment to another party. Exceptionally a licence may be granted to the owner of the land and its successors in title.
- 2.2. An applicant granted a licence becomes an undertaker for the purposes of the Act, any secondary legislation, and codes or practice. This means that the applicant must comply with certain duties and responsibilities. For example, the applicant will be required to issue street works notices and/or pay charges pursuant to section 74 and/or S74A of the Act for occupation of the street. Applicants not familiar with the requirements of this legislation are strongly advised to seek professional advice and to appoint a contractor with the appropriate knowledge to help complete this application and to conduct the works on their behalf. Non-compliance with any requirement of the Act may result in penalties and future applications being rejected. The licence holder cannot delegate this liability to any other person or organisation.
- 2.3. During and upon completion of the proposed works, Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea officers will require access to the works in order to carry out inspections.

- 2.4. The proposed works and site set up must conform to all current codes of practice and legislation. The needs of vulnerable road users must be met at all times.
- 2.5. The works must be carried out and completed without delay and in accordance with a schedule of work agreed with the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea Highways Licensing Engineer who grants your licence.
- 2.6. The Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea must be indemnified by the applicant against any claims for injury, damage or loss arising out of the placing or the presence of the apparatus or the execution of any works authorised by the licence.
- 2.7. In addition, the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea may stipulate in the licence any conditions that they consider appropriate in the interests of safety, to minimise the inconvenience to persons using the street or to protect the structure of the street and integrity of the apparatus in it.
- 2.8. For the purposes of protecting and maintaining the condition of the highway asset, the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea requires a deposit that is held on account for use in the event that the licensee fails to respond and take the required remedial action to a defect notification in respect of the works undertaken. This deposit will be held until the relevant guarantee period has elapsed and the applicant has requested the return of any residue sum using the form provisioned within Appendix E.
- 2.9. The owner of the apparatus has a statutory duty to ensure the apparatus is properly maintained at all times.
- 2.10. Where the applicant to the licence proposes to cease using the apparatus or dispose of its interest in the apparatus, a minimum of six weeks advance written notice must be given to the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea Project Engineer. If the licence is for the benefit of the owner and its successors in title, then advance notice must be given to the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea Project Engineer of any transfer of the interest. Failure to comply with this requirement is an offence and may be liable on summary conviction to a financial penalty.
- 2.11. If a licence expires or is withdrawn or surrendered, then the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea may remove the apparatus from the street or alter it in such a manner as it thinks fit and reinstate the street. The costs of these works will be recovered from the applicant. Alternatively, the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea may require that the applicant remove or alter the apparatus at the licence holders' cost.
- 2.12. A record of the works and apparatus will be kept by the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea' Network Management Team and on the Department for Transport's Street Manager system.

3. Application for a Licence

3.1. The completed Section 50 application and all enquiries relating to the application should be sent to the Network Management Team:

- 3.2. In order for the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea to comply with its statutory duties, all applications for a Section 50 licence must be submitted three months in advance of the proposed works start date for works that require a Temporary Traffic Order (TTO) and/or are 11 days or more in duration. All other types of works must be submitted one month in advance of the proposed works start date.
- 3.3. All applicants requesting a Section 50 licence must complete application form (see Appendix A) and submit all information required in the application pack as listed below:
 - One copy of a scale location plan at 1:1250 showing the proposed location and depth of the relevant apparatus marked by a red broken line.
 - A copy of traffic management drawing.
 - Evidence of Public Liability Insurance to a minimum of £10,000,000 in respect of any one claim.
 - Confirmation that the applicant has written to all statutory undertakers who may have apparatus in the street which may be affected (a list of relevant undertakers is provided as <u>Appendix G</u> of this document).
 - Valid copies of street works qualifications (badges/certificates) for all of the operatives and supervisors who will carry out works on behalf of the Section 50 licence holder.
 - Works involving the use of portable light signals and/or a traffic order to prohibit traffic will require separate approvals. Copies of these applications/approvals must be submitted with the Section 50 application.
 - Estimated size of the excavation(s) for both footway and carriageway.
- 3.4. Once your application has been received, you will be provided with a reference number. Once you have received your reference number, payment to the sum of £942.00 for the application fee and inspection charges is to be made by BACS or credit/debit card. <u>Your application will not be processed until this</u> <u>payment is made</u>.
- 3.5. A deposit for the sum stated in section 5.2 of the application pack will also be required. The deposit amount will be notified to you in writing.

4. Application for a Licence for an Additional Phase of Works -

Remedial Works/Interim to Permanent Reinstatement

- 4.1. The completed Section 50 Additional Phase of Works application and all associated NRSWA 1991 notifications should be sent by email to both: <u>Highwayslicenceapplications@rbkc.gov.uk</u> and <u>Notices@rbkc.gov.uk</u>
- 4.2. All applications for a Section 50 additional phase of works licence must be submitted with as much notice as possible to ensure works do not conflict with other planned works in the borough.
- 4.3. All applicants requesting a Section 50 additional phase of works licence must complete the application form (see Appendix B) and submit all information required in the application pack as listed below:
 - A copy of traffic management drawing.
 - Valid copies of street works qualifications (badges/certificates) for all of the operatives and supervisors who will carry out works on behalf of the Section 50 licence holder.
 - Works involving the use of portable light signals and/or a traffic order to prohibit traffic will require separate approvals. Copies of these applications/approvals must be submitted with the Section 50 application.
 - The sum of £284.00 for the application fee is required. Payment is to be made by BACS or credit/debit card. <u>Your application will not</u> <u>be processed until this payment is made</u>.

5. Variation/Extension Application

- 5.1. The completed Section 50 variation application should be sent by email to both: <u>Highwayslicenceapplications@rbkc.gov.uk</u> and <u>Notices@rbkc.gov.uk</u>
- 5.2. All applications to vary the scope of the licence and/or extend the duration of the licence period must complete the application form (see Appendix F).
- 5.3. The sum of £77.00 for the application fee is required for each variation/extension application that is granted. Payment is to be made by BACS or credit/debit card.
- 5.4. You will not be charged if your application is refused.

6. Licence Charges

6.2. Deposits

As identified in Sections 2.8 and 3.3 above, a deposit is also required which will be held on account for the duration of the guarantee period determined by the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991. The licensee will be required to rectify any defects associated with the works in a timely manner as prescribed by the Code of Practice for Street Works Inspections. Should the licensee fail to respond to any defect inspection notices in an appropriate manner as prescribed by the Code of Practice for Street Works Inspections, the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea may take reasonable remedial action and deduct all reasonable costs incurred, including officer time and an administration cost, from the deposit received. Any costs incurred that exceed the deposit amount will be reclaimed from the licensee.

This deposit will be taken as a separate payment to the Section 50 fee and will be fully refundable to the applicant upon receipt of a request and satisfactory completion of a final inspection of the works before the applicable guarantee period expires.

A deposit holding fee of £66 is also payable at the time of making the payment of your deposit. This holding fee is non-refundable.

7. Other Required NRSWA 1991 Activity Notifications

- 7.1. Under NRSWA 1991 works promoters (licence holder) are required to provide the following notices once the works have commenced. Failure to provide these notices in a timely manner could result in a Fixed Penalty Notice (FPN) being issued for each offence committed. The Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea Section 50 Team will raise a permit on Street Manager to register your works. This unique reference number will be sent to you and all notices must quote this number to ensure information is recorded accurately.
- 7.2. In order to comply with S74 of NRSWA 1991, the licence holder must provide an 'actual start' notice (as provided in Appendix C) to the Highway Authority to inform them that the works have actually began. This notice must be received by the Highway Authority within 2 hours after the works commenced. This notice must be emailed to both: Highwayslicenceapplications@rbkc.gov.uk and Notices@rbkc.gov.uk

7.3. In order to comply with S74 of NRSWA 1991, the licence holder must provide a 'works closed' notice (as provided in Appendix D) to the Highway Authority once the street has been permanently reinstated and all spoil, materials, signing, lighting and guarding has been removed from site. The works closed notice must be received by the Highway Authority by the end of the next working day (4pm) on which the activity was closed. This notice must be emailed to both:

7.4. In order to comply with S70 of NRSWA, the applicant must provide a 'registration of reinstatement' notice (as provided in <u>Appendix E</u>) to the Highway Authority following the completion of permanent reinstatement and the sending of a works closed notice. The registration of reinstatement must be received by the Highway Authority within 2 hours of completing the works and removing all materials and equipment from the site. This notice must be emailed to both:

7.5. Section 74 – Overrunning Works Charges

- 6.5.1 Under NRSWA 1991 Highway Authorities can charge section 50 Licence holders a Section 74 over run fee if street works take longer than previously agreed. A daily charge is applicable for each working day that the works exceed over the prescribed/agreed period. The daily charge varies according to the road category, traffic sensitivity and if works affect the footway or carriageway at any time during the period of overrun
- 6.5.2 Applicants must ensure that they are familiar with the rules, regulations and fees associated with overrunning works. Further information can be found within Regulation 4 of The Street Works (Charges for Unreasonably Prolonged Occupation of the Highway) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2012

6.6 Variation Requests

- 6.6.1 Any requirement that fundamentally changes the scope of the works, including any amendment to the planned dates, originally specified within the application will require the Highway Authority to process and reassess these proposals for impact to the road network and check for any conflicts with other works where any changes to dates are requested.
- 6.6.2 Any requirement to extend the end date of the licence period must be requested no later than 2 working days before the current end date of the licence. A valid reason must also be provided when submitting an extension request.
- 6.6.3 The licence holder must submit a Variation Application (as provided in <u>Appendix F</u>) to the Highway Authority to inform them of the requirement to amend the scope of works and/or extend the duration of works. This notice must be emailed to both: <u>Highwayslicenceapplications@rbkc.gov.uk</u> and <u>Notices@rbkc.gov.uk</u>

6.6.4 A fee of £77.00 (non-refundable) is applicable for each variation application once granted. Payment is to be made by BACS or credit/debit card.

6.7 <u>Future Maintenance Costs</u>

6.7.1 Any future maintenance works required to the apparatus placed as part of the granted S50 licence, or any remedial measures to the reinstatement of the street that qualify as registerable works under the Act will need to be processed and evaluated by the Highway Authority. The charge applicable is determined by the registerable works activity categorisation for the proposed works.

Further information on registerable works can be found within section 7.3 of the Code of Practice for the Coordination of Street and Road Works.

6.8 Additional Inspection Fees

- 6.8.1 Under NRSWA 1991, Highway Authorities are permitted to recover the costs of inspections undertaken, as set-out in the Department for Transport's Code of Practice for Inspections.
- 6.8.2 The Licence application fee includes a payment for undertaking a minimum of three sample inspections. Each sample inspection is chargeable at £50.00 per inspection.

Further Information can be found within section 7.1 of the Code of Practice for Street Works Inspections

6.9 Remedial Works Undertaken by the Street Authority

6.9.1 Under NRSWA 1991, Highway Authorities can undertake remedial works where works promoters perform unsatisfactorily in responding to defect notifications issued by the authority and charge their reasonable costs to the licensee.

Further Information can be found within section 4.2 of the Code of Practice for Street Works Inspections.

6.10 Legal Fees and Expenses

- 6.10.1. Part 3 of NRSWA 1991 details a range of statutory duties and obligations placed on works promoters (licence holder) and the offences associated with failing to comply with them. A Highway Authority has the power to prosecute a works promoter in the Magistrates Court for an alleged failure to comply with legislation. The maximum fine that can be imposed by a Magistrate for an offence is unlimited.
- 6.10.2. In addition, a Highway Authority may choose to give a Fixed Penalty Notice (FPN) to a works promoter for failing to comply with legislation.

An FPN offers a works promoter the opportunity to discharge any liability to conviction for an offence, by payment of a fee. However, the Highway Authority retains the power to take an alleged offender to the Magistrates Courts instead of issuing an FPN.

6.10.3. The penalty is £120.00 which must be paid within 36 calendar days. A discounted amount of £80.00 will apply if payment is made within 29 calendar days. Further Information can be found within Chapter 11 of the Code of Practice for the Coordination of Street and Road Works.
