As someone living adjacent to RBKC who has been affected by basement developments I would like to comment on this document.

I believe that it seeks to address, ameliorate and largely overcome the problems experienced by residents with the large number of basements that have been developed over the last 5+ years and the increasing number that continue to be applied for. It recognises the effect that these developments has on the quality of life of residents particularly as they typically take between one year and 18 months to complete the building stage. They create problems with traffic, dust, dirt and noise. In addition there is no certainty of the long term cumulative impact that these excavations will have on structural stability or the water environment.

In my short street of some 50 houses over the past 5+ years there has been 12 basement extensions plus a further 2 in the pipeline. This has degraded my quality of life during this period.


I fully support the Council's efforts to achieve a balanced approach on these developments so ensuring that residents have an acceptable quality of life.
