WHEREAS the Council of the Royal Forough of Kensington and Chelsea being the local planning authority for the said Borough are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto should not be carried out on the land known as 1-4 10 13-15 (inclusive) Holland Villas Road W14 in the Inner Area of London shown within an unbroken black line and coloured red on the plan annexed hereto unless permission is granted on an application in that behalf

AND WHEREAS is opinion of the said Council development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto would constitute a threat to the amenities of their area_____

MCWCMERS OF BORE the said Council in pursuance of the Fowers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Lountry Planning General Development Order 1977 and in accordance with the procedure set cut in Paragraph 3(b) of the said Article 4 HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by article 3 of the

said Order shall not apply to development, on the said land of the descriptions set out in the Schedule hereto______

THE development medermed to in Class (1) 1 and (1) 3 specified in Schedule 1 to the said Order and not being development comprised within any other class that is to say:—

CLASS 1. Perelopment within the curtilege of a dwellinghouse

The enlargement improvement or other alteration of a cycllinghouse so long as:

(a) the cubic content of the original dwellinghouse (as excertained by external measurement) is not exceeded by more than 50 cubic metres or one-tenth whichever is the greater subject to a maximum of 115 cubic metres.
