## Royal Borough of Kensington & Chelsea Local Development Framework Core Strategy Hearing Agenda for Third Day


Thank you for sending British Waterways the agenda for the third day hearings on Matter 5 – Strategic Sites Allocations: Kensal Gasworks and Wornington Green.

We have just one further comment to make in response to the Matters and Issues for Discussion. Item 5 seeks to assess how deliverable the connections are, including the bridging of the canal. We would also, as previously mentioned in our response, like to understand how this might be delivered, and what aims this would achieve for the area in terms of the connection made, considering the position of the cemetary. While we are happy to support improvements to access to the waterway, we are keen that the LPA recognise the additional maintenance and safety burden bridges can place on British Waterways, and this should be considered in the feasibility and ongoing maintenance assessment of any new proposals. The adjacent towpath and necessary works to it should also be considered as part of this, as this forms an important sustainable transport corridor to support pedestrian and cycle access to and from the site.
