Play Spaces:

- Type A: "Door-step" spaces
- Type B: "Neighbourhood" spaces
- Type C: "Local" spaces

Catchment areas:

- Type A: 100m walking distance (60m buffer)
- Type B: 400m walking distance (240m buffer)
- Type C: 1000m walking distance (600m buffer)

The types of spaces form a hierarchy. This means a Type C space also performs the functions of a Type B and a Type A space. A Type B also performs the functions of Type A space.


