- B. Applications for the renewal of licences will be subject to the same terms and conditions as the existing licence(s). Should applicants wish to amend any details, e.g. extend the hours or increase the accommodation figure, a separate application to vary the existing licence will need to be made. Please contact the Licensing Team at the address below for the relevant forms.
- C. In most cases a decision will not be made until at least 4 weeks from the date on which the application is made.
- D. All convictions must be disclosed however spent convictions as defined overleaf need not be included. Details of convictions should be disclosed on a separate sheet of paper and not on the application form
- E. Exhibition and Near Beer Licences cease at 11pm. Should applicants wish to continue beyond 11pm an extension of hours must be applied for.
